From the Pastor

"The Glorious Light of Christmas"

"In him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind." John 1:4, NIV

On December 4, 2022 at 1:03 a.m. there was a significant breakthrough at the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory. Using powerful lasers to create heat and pressure, the kinds inside a star, there was enough to drive atoms together releasing tremendous energy in a process called "Ignition." Nuclear fusion is called the "Holy Grail" of clean energy. Basically, we are learning to harness the incredible power of the stars. This immeasurable and awesome power of energy and light, John says finds it source in the Word, the Creator, the one who is "life" and "the light of all mankind."

The astounding affirmation about Jesus, the Word is that he is the source of life and he is the glorious light by which people are pointed to God. Twice in John's Gospel Jesus calls himself the light of the world (8:12; 9:5). Three things stand out about Jesus and the light. (1) The light Jesus brings is the light which dispels chaos. It brings peace, harmony. In the creation story God moved upon the dark, formless chaos and said, "Let there be light" (Gen. 1:3). Jesus is the light that shines in the darkness bringing order out of the chaos of our lives (1:5). (2) The light which Jesus brings is a revealing light. We never see ourselves until we see ourselves through the eyes of Jesus. And when we see ourselves, we are driven to God. Psalm 36:9 reads, "For with you is the fountain of life; in your light we see light" (my emphasis). (3) The light which Jesus brings is a quiding light. Without God's light we walk in darkness (Jn. 8:12; 12:36), like people stumbling on a dark and unfamiliar path. But with his glorious light the way is clear. "In your light we see light."

As we enter the season of Advent and Christmas, we celebrate the glorious "light of all mankind" who has come to us bringing peace and salvation and we joyfully proclaim and reflect his "glorious light" to all who sit in places of darkness. This is the season to "let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven" (Matt. 5:16). As you view this Winter edition of the Good Newsletter aside from our regular schedule of worship and Bible studies you will find seasonal events and activities that represent opportunities for spiritual growth, fellowship, service, and outreach. Pray for people in your life, and for opportunities to invite people to Bible study, or worship, or one of our special Christmas community events. And thank you for your faithfulness to love all people and to let the glorious light of Christ shine through you to bless others with the Gospel in our community.




The Season of Advent






