¹⁸ "The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to set the oppressed free, ¹⁹ to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor." Luke 4:18-19

Praise God! It is the time of God's favor! Jesus' life was empowered by the Spirit and marked by love and clarity of purpose and mission, to proclaim good news to the poor, freedom for the oppressed, sight for the blind, and liberation for the captives. The gospel is directed toward people whose only hope is that God will act on their behalf to accomplish liberation and healing. And Jesus did identify primarily with the socially, religiously, and economically excluded people of his day. His mission is inclusive, restorative, and focused on those in need. Who are those in need around us? We have good news to embody, it is the time of God's favor!

The language Jesus used reminds us of the Year of Jubilee in Leviticus 25:8-17, one year in 50 when debts were forgiven and slaves set free. Jesus is saying, "The year of the Lord's favor" is here! God has brought humanity freedom from the guilt and effects of sin, we are loved, forgiven and set free in Christ! The omission of Isaiah 61:2 in Luke 4:19 was intentional. That verse adds, "and the day of vengeance of our God." Today is the time of the "Lord's favor," not the time of judgment. That is good news! "For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him" (Jn. 3:17). The mission of declaring God's favor, His grace continues today and we have the joy to bring hope, healing, and freedom to all people, to say, "Come unto me, all who are weary and burdened [who feel guilty, judged, shut out from God, unloved], and I will give you rest" (Matt. 11:28). Praise God! It is the time of God's favor!

As you view this Spring edition of the Good Newsletter aside from our regular schedule of worship and Bible studies you will find seasonal Easter events and activities that represent opportunities for spiritual growth, fellowship, and service – loving our neighbors. Pray for people in your life, and for opportunities to embody Christ's message of hope, healing, and freedom to those in need.

The next meeting dates are March 11th, April 8th and May 13th.


